



WEATHER FORECAST

Recommended for Ages 3 – 8

Spring is here! The weather can sometimes feel unpredictable. Talk to your child about the weather person on the news. Discuss that their job is to study the weather so they can tell us what the weather will be like in the next few days.

You will need:

- Pencils, crayons, or markers
- Paper

Instructions:

Discuss what these words mean:

- Cloudy
- Windy
- Rain

- Sunny
- Warm
- Hot

- Partly Cloudy
- Cold



Discuss the icons to the left. Ask your child to draw about:

- How can you show temperature?
- How can you show wind?

More Weather Forecast Ideas and Activities:

- What words can you use to describe a windy day, a sunny day, a rainy day?
- Discuss what the temperature range might be on those days.
- Have your child draw or write a weather forecast for tomorrow.
