



FUN WITH TAPE

Recommended for Ages 3+

Got masking or painter's tape? Here are some fun activities to bust the boredom and work on motor skills and coordination.

Multi-Use Road or Maze

Create a road or maze out of painters' tape that won't ruin your floor or carpet. You can use the road or maze you make for the following two activities for hours of fun.

Town and Car

You will need the following materials: small cars, blocks, cereal or snack boxes, and small toys

How to play:

Kids can use their toy cars to travel the road or maze. They can make a town using other small toys, cereal boxes, and blocks.

Maze Race

You will need the following materials: paper or cotton ball, and a straw

How to play:

Wad up the small piece of paper or use a large cotton ball. Use the straw to blow the ball from one end of the maze to the other.

Tape Shape Game

You will need the following materials: floor space and painter's tape

How to play:

Create shapes and letters on the floor, large enough for kids to see from a short distance and stand on. Give your child a variety of directions to get from one shape/letter to the other. For example, hop like a frog to the square, tip toe to the letter T, jump to the letter, E, crabwalk to the triangle. Let your child give you directions to shapes and letters too. More suggestions: crawl, skip, act like a monkey, slither, walk on your knees, and bear claw.
