



GUESSING GAMES

Recommended for Ages 3+

These guessing games are simple and fun. They are easily changed to fit any situation or group of kids. Kids can get creative and change up the rules too.

I Spy

Use objects in the room, or look out a window, pick one and say I spy with my eyes something that is...and describe the object in one or two words. Take turns spying and guessing. You can challenge each other by limiting the number of guesses.

Toy Hide and Seek

Take turns hiding and looking for a stuffed animal, other toy, or ball. You can also hide several things for kids to find. Don't forget to count how many things you hide.

20 Questions

One person picks an object and another person has 20 questions to guess what it is. Take turns picking the object and guessing. Option: you can divide the 20 questions among a group of kids.

Guess the Mystery Object

Find an object, use a paper bag to hide the object. Players reach in, feel the object, and without looking, guess what it is. Take turns picking and hiding an object in the bag. Option: put a few objects in a bag that are related and have the players guess the concept or idea. For example, a few plastic toy animals and kids can guess "animals you see at the zoo". Another example, salt-shaker, fork, napkin and kids can guess "things you eat your food with".
