



Make Your Own Bird Feeder

Recommended for Ages 5 – 8

You will need the following supplies:

- Toilet paper roll
- Peanut butter (other nut butters or Crisco oil can be substituted if you have an allergy).
- Seeds (sunflower seeds or sesame seeds)
- Stick
- Yarn or string
- Holepunch (if available)

Instructions:

- 1. Use a holepunch to make two small holes at the top of the toilet paper roll OR put a stick through the toilet paper roll so it sticks out both sides.
- 2. Tie a string or yarn to the toilet paper role by tying to the holes you punched OR to the ends to the stick. The idea is to make a hanger for your toilet paper roll so you can place it on a tree branch outside.
- 3. Cover entire toilet paper roll with peanut butter.
- 4. Roll it in seeds. The seeds will stick to the peanut butter.
- 5. Hang outside and wait for birds to find it.

Do you see any birds? Maybe you will get an unexpected visitor, such as a squirrel, etc.
