



TEAR PAPER ART

Recommended for Ages 5 – 8

Spring is here and that is when you may see animals in water. What animals would you find in a pond, an ocean, or a river? What would be around your pond, ocean, or river?



You will need the following materials:

- Paper
- Glue

Use paper to make an original masterpiece. Tear off paper to make a pond, ocean, or river and glue it on a larger sheet of paper.

- 1. Use a blue sheet of paper as your water.
- 2. Tear around orange or yellow paper to make a duck figure, brown paper to make a tree trunk, and green paper to make grass or leaves.
- 3. Glue your items in the correct place, e.g. ducks in water, trees on grass.
