



Portraits and Interview

Recommended for Ages 8 - 12

You will need the following supplies:

- Blank paper
- Pencil
- Optional: colored pencils, markers, yarn, glue, or small craft accessories to embellish.

Instructions:

- 1. Draw a portrait of someone you know. It can be simple as drawing an oval and then drawing eyes, eyebrows, nose, lips, ears. Do your best.
- Add accessories to your portrait with materials you have. For example: glue yarn for hair.
- 3. Interview your person and place the answers on another piece of paper.

Sample Interview Questions:

- In what city were you born?
- What is one of your favorite childhood memories?
- What is one of your favorite books?
- What is one of your favorite movies or television shows?
- Do you have a favorite song?
- Do you speak any other languages?
- What countries and/or cities have you visited?
- Have you visited any museums?
- Do you have a favorite artist or artwork that you admire?
- What was your first job?
- What was your favorite subject in school?
- 4. Then switch turns. You become the subject of the portrait and you are being interviewed.
