



COFFEE FILTER FLOWERS

Recommended for Ages 5 – 8

Create beautiful coffee filter flowers to display in a vase or hang on a string to create a fun garland. Use household supplies and bring on the imagination.

You will need the following materials:

- Coffee filters
- Paper Towel
- Markers
- Twist tie, chenille stem, or string

Directions:

- 1. Color a design on the coffee filters, making enough for a bouquet.
- 2. Fold filters into a triangle shape, then dip the tip into a small bowl or jar of water.
- 3. Observe the color spread. Unfold the filter and let it dry on a clean paper towel.
- 4. Once dried, set filters aside but save the paper towel with the colored residue remaining as this can work as an additional flower.
- 5. Cut out each of the designs on the dried paper towel to fit inside the filter.
- 6. Fold filter and paper towel over and twist the bottom from the center to make a flower. Repeat this step for desired number of flowers.
- 7. Wrap the ends with a twist tie, chenille stem, or string to secure the flower and make a stem.
- 8. Enjoy or give as a gift.
