



PIPE CLEANER CREATURES HOW CREATIVE ARE YOU?

Recommended for Ages 5 − 8

What can you make with Pipe Cleaners? There are two examples below. Can you make something new and different?

You will need the following materials:

- Pipe Cleaners
- Pom Poms



Mushroom Pencil Topper

- 1. Roll a pipe cleaner into a circle.
- Take a small pom-pom the same color as your pipe cleaner and glue it to the center of the circle.
- 3. Push the pom-pom to make the pipe cleaner form a half sphere.
- 4. Glue small white pom poms to the outside, directly on to the pipe cleaner.
- 5. Grab a white pipe cleaner and bend it in half, cutting off one of the halves.
- 6. Wrap one of the halves around the top of a pencil for shape and glue the top of the white pipe cleaner to the head of the mushroom.



Bumble Bee

- 1. Wrap a yellow pipe cleaner twice around a pencil.
- Cut a black pipe cleaner in half and take one half to intertwine with yellow pipe cleaner. For every twist of the black pipe cleaner, do two twists of the yellow.
- 3. For the wings, take a white pipe cleaner and bend in half. Then twist each end towards the bend forming circles on both sides.
- 4. Cut a second white pipe cleaner in half, bend, and intersect it with the bend of the first wings. Repeat the process of twisting to form circles.
- 5. Glue wings onto the body.
- 6. Add antenna by bending half a black pipe cleaner and twist until they form circles.
