



POM-POM IN A CUP GAME

Recommended for Ages 5 – 9

Items Needed:

Paper or plastic cup, pencil, scissors, string, school glue, and a pom-pom

Instructions:

- 1. Poke a small hole in the bottom of a cup that is just big enough to put a pencil through.
- 2. Tie a string to the pencil under the cup. Make sure to cut the string long enough that it can reach inside the cup.
- 3. On the other end of the string, glue or tie a pom-pom ball to the string. Let it sit until the glue dries.
- 4. The object of the game is to see if you can get the pom-pom into the cup. Hold on to the cup by the pencil, swing the cup forward and then back to you in a swinging motion to see if you can swing the pom-pom into the cup! Good luck!
