



Paper Moving Fish

Recommended for Ages 6+

Materials:

- Colorful paper
- Scissors
- Markers
- Glue stick
- String (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Begin by cutting a square sheet of paper, 2 circle eyes, and 2 heart shapes (one heart bigger than the other heart).
- 2. Fold paper diagonally creating a triangle shape. Unfold.
- 3. Facing up like a diamond, fold each end towards the middle and then unfold. Paper will have 3 crease diagonal lines. Unfold back into triangle shape.
- 4. Begin from the "tail" make cuts with scissors from center towards the crease, evenly. Leave a larger portion uncut for "head." Unfold paper.
- 5. Glue one of the flaps of the triangles onto the other triangle.
- 6. Gently press and shape the fish.
- 7. Glue the small heart to the "tail" of fish. Glue the bigger heart closer to the "head" of the fish.
- 8. Place eyes on fish. Tie string to the middle of the fish.
