- A device with access to the internet
- Paper
- Pencil or pen

Challenges:

1. Go on an art scavenger hunt! Look for:
 - a. A painting by a woman artist
 - b. A cultural object made out of clay or wood
 - c. A cultural object made out of gold or metal
 - d. A portrait of a child or teen
 - e. An artwork that is at least 400 years old
 - f. One funny artwork
 - g. One sad artwork
2. Visit a museum virtually located at least 1,000 miles away from your home. Such as a museum in Chicago, New York, Central America, Mexico, Europe, Asia, or Africa.
