



Catalog and Organize Your Collection

Recommended for Ages 9+

Do you have a collection of small treasures? It's a great time to catalog and organize your collections.

Materials:

- A collection of objects such as marbles, small toys, buttons, rocks, coins, plastic jewelry, stamps, etc.
- Notebook paper
- Ruler
- Pencil or pen



Instructions:

- 1. Organize your collection by their most notable feature (color, size, number of sides, etc.)
- 2. Measure each object in inches width x height and write a description of its other notable features on the paper.
- 3. Add details about your object, such as where it comes from or how long you have owned the item.
- 4. Create your own home museum and display your objects proudly. You can use a baking tray, empty shelf, shoe box or other small space in your home. Switch out your objects every week to create a new show.
